The CTCC is offering 4 scholarships (each worth 50% of tuition fees) to study on the MA Cultural Tourism. Home, EU and Overseas applicants will be considered for these scholarships. Scholarships must be taken up in the academic year 2008-9 and cannot be deferred. Successful scholarship applicants will be notified by the end of July 2008.

Scholarships will only be available to candidates accepted on the MA Cultural Tourism course. When applying, you should therefore either already hold an offer letter for this MA or send at the same time (but in a different letter or email) an application to Leeds Metropolitan University Central Admissions (details on MA application form). A small committee made up from the MA course team will evaluate applications based upon your academic achievements, what you communicate through your 1,000 word statement and evidence of your capacity to complete the MA. Please bear in mind that the competition for scholarships is very high indeed. It is important that you present a high quality application.

### **English Language Proficiency**

Applicants whose first language is not English and who do not have a degree from a UK, USA, Canadian, Australian or New Zealand University, will need to produce evidence of proficiency in English. Certificates must be for tests taken no earlier than September 2005. We require either an International English Language Testing Score (IELTS) of no less than 6.5 for each component of the test or a Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a score of at least 600 with TWE of 5.0.
